

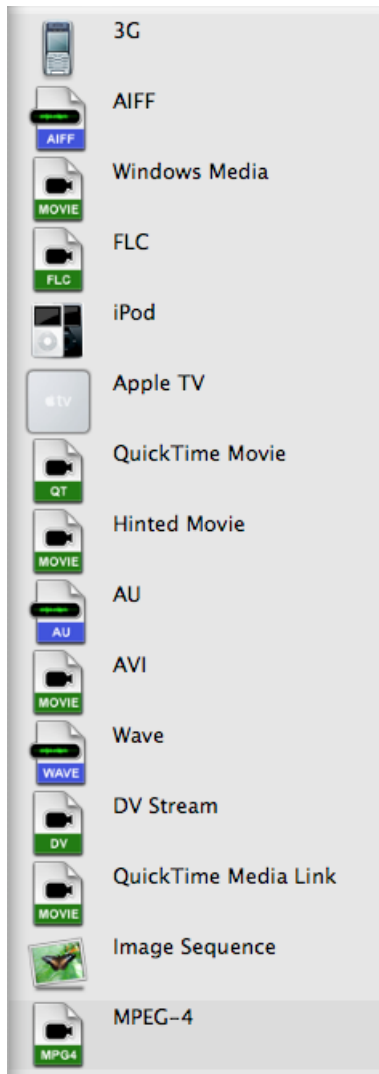


When you download ReelBean you get versions for both Tiger (2.99) and Leopard (3.6). Use whichever you want, or both.

REELBEAN 3.6

ReelBean from JS8 Media is a movie player and converter application for Mac OS X containing many powerful features that usually are only available in expensive video processing software. These include converting videos to many different formats, such as iPod, Apple TV, iPhone, MPEG-4, H.264, QuickTime, AVI and oth-

ers. It also allows individual tracks (video, audio, etc) to be extracted to separate files, allows adding of an audio file as a new track to an existing movie, and many other movie manipulation capabilities. ReelBean features a scene selection drawer, a video transparency slider, a playback speed controller, and useful features such as the ability to start a video file from the last point played when previously opened.



MAIN FEATURES

Converts movies (formats include iPod, Apple TV, iPhone, MPEG-4, QuickTime, H.264, 3G (phones), DV, image sequences, AVI, AIFF, AU, Wave and many others (some are listed to the left.)

Extract video and audio tracks from movies into new individual files, and edit videos.

Adjustable video transparency controller, and playback speed controller.

Play audio and video in over 50 formats.

Display a scene selection drawer for all movie formats listed above.

ReelBean 3 for Leopard detects chapters if they exist in a movie file and displays a HUD panel to allow them to be selected.

Split and join movies to/from separate movie files with one click of a button.

Video and audio recording.

Add audio tracks to videos.

Display and add video annotations (searchable with Spotlight)

Play streaming videos and DVDs.

Display video info panels, change playback speed, allow auto starting of movies on opening, start movies from the last point played on opening.
